- The county will not accept any commercial/industrial generated hazardous waste.
- The county will not accept any material which cannot be legally disposed of at a hazardous waste facility.
- Do not mix materials.
- Tighten lids on all containers. If containers are leaking, pack in larger container with newspaper to soak up leaks.
- Bring all substances in original containers with labels. <u>Items must be identifiable</u>.
- Alkaline household batteries may be thrown in the trash.
- Maximum amount accepted 25 gallons or 220 lbs. No 25 or 50 gallon drums

<sup>\*</sup> Take off lid, dry out paint, discard can without lid; or pour paint into plastic bag with absorbent material (clay based kitty litter, saw dust, rags) place bag and can without lid, in trash. Paint hardener can also be purchased at hardware stores.
