

## Fire Pit / Recreational Fires Regulations

- 1. Needs approval of the Borough's Code Official. Call the Borough Office at 610.593.6854.
- 2. Must always be attended by adult.
- 3. Means to extinguish must be readily available. Acceptable forms are: extinguisher, garden hose, water barrel, sand or dirt.
- 4. Recreational fires not contained in a store bought UL listed portable fireplace must be at least 25 feet from any structure or combustible material. Fires may not be greater than 3 feet in diameter.
- 5. Portable UL listed fireplaces must be used according to the manufacturer's instructions and may not be closer than 15 feet to any structure or combustible material.
- 6. Bonfires or fires greater than 3 feet in diameter are prohibited without Borough and Fire Department approval.
- 7. Burning of yard waste and trash is prohibited.
- 8. Use of an approved recreation fire is prohibited when conditions are unsafe for its use such as high winds, high fire hazard due to drought or dry weather.
- 9. Operators are to be mindful of smoke direction and shall operate the recreation fire in a manner that does not cause a nuisance to neighbors.
