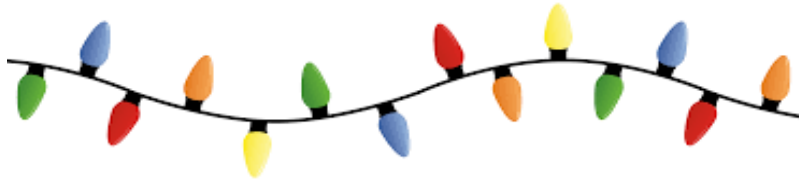

### CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP AND DISPOSAL BY ATGLEN CUB SCOUT PACK 20



Are you DONE with your tree and READY to Get It Gone? Instead of placing the tree next to your household trash to be put in the AJ Blosenski trash truck compactor, utilize an environmentally friendly option. Let the Atglen Cub Scout Pack 20 get your tree. For a small donation the Cub Scouts will stop by your residence, pick up your tree, and take it to a location in which they will chip the tree. The tree must be free of all ornaments and garland.

The Cub Scout option is easy. Here are the steps:

1. Type this URL link: <https://forms.gle/4B6BPgBYatTN2UX46> into your internet browser or go to the Borough's website, [atglen.org](http://atglen.org), to grab the URL link or QR Code. Complete the form and hit submit. (If you need assistance signing up, give us a call at Borough Hall and we will help.)
2. Take your tree to the curb for pick-up on the date you selected - December 28, or January 2, or January 8
3. Make a \$10 (or more) donation to Cub Scout Pack 20. Sit back and let the scouts do the rest!

### WINTER MAINTENANCE

Help us in keeping the streets and community safe.

- During a snow event do not park your vehicles on the local roads. This allows us to plow the traffic lanes without interference from vehicles.
- When you are clearing your driveway and sidewalk do **not** put the snow in the street. Keep the snow on your property. When you shovel the snow into the street you create an icing and unsafe condition.
- **Clear the sidewalks from snow and ice within the first few hours after the weather event. The law mandates a 2 hour response.**
- Place your trash and recycling containers out of the path of the snow plow.

Running toilets and leaking faucets can quickly cause your water bill to increase dramatically. Check periodically for leaks in the kitchen or bathroom and address them immediately.
