Hydrant flushing will take place on Tuesday, October 11th (rain date Thursday, October 13th).

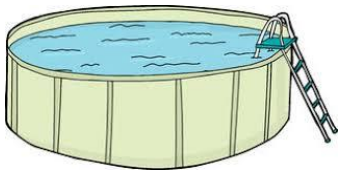
Sometimes this creates a change in the appearance of your household drinking water. The water may appear discolored or cloudy. The water has been treated and is safe to drink, cook, and bathe.

Before you wash your clothes confirm the water is running clear. If you ran the washing machine and the laundry appears discolored do not use bleach. Bleach will set the rust stain in the clothing.

SWIMMING POOL WINTERIZATION



As a component of winterizing your swimming pools, if you must remove some pool water please drain the water onto a grass surface in your yard. You cannot discharge the pool water directly into the Borough streets or storm drains. Thank you for helping us remain in compliance with PA DEP MS4 requirements.

LEAF COLLECTION

Weather permitting, leaf collection will take place every Monday beginning Monday, October 24th and continuing until early December. Rake your leaves into a pile along the gutter. Remove branches, grass cuttings and other debris.

Our leaf collection equipment is 12 feet high. If you have tree limbs that hang less than 12 feet above the road, trim the limbs to prevent breakage.
